

Refuse information for temporary residents of low-rise homes

This refuse information applies to your personal situation.

Refuse refers to everything that we throw away. There are different kinds of refuse.

This information explains how and where you should dispose of your refuse.

Vegetable and garden waste (GFT)

GFT should be deposited in the container with the green lid. Netwerk empties this container once every two weeks. The dates are given on the waste calendar. On these dates you must place your container outside before 7.30 a.m., preferably as close to other containers as possible. It is not permitted to place refuse next to the containers.

General household waste

General household waste should be deposited in the container with the grey lid. Netwerk empties this container once every two weeks. The dates are given on the waste calendar. On these dates you must place your container outside before 7.30 a.m., preferably as close to other containers as possible. It is not permitted to place refuse next to the containers.

Domestic chemical waste (KCA)

KCA must be handed over to the KCA collection van. You can also bring KCA to the municipal waste depot. If you have missed the KCA collection van and are unable to go to the municipal waste depot, you can have this waste collected from your home. To arrange this you can make an appointment with the Netwerk customer service.

Waste paper and cardboard

Waste paper and cardboard can be deposited in the container with the blue lid. If you do not have a container, you can tie up your waste paper with string or put it in a cardboard box. Netwerk collects waste paper and cardboard once a month. The dates are given on the waste calendar. If Netwerk collects the paper on a Saturday, it should be placed outside before 9.00 a.m. on that day. On other collection days (Monday through Friday) the paper should be placed outside by 5.30 p.m. No other waste may be placed outside on these collection days.

Netwerk will send the relevant waste calendar to your home by post as soon as possible.

Businesses

This refuse information does not apply to businesses. For the disposal of business waste you need to conclude a contract with a waste collection company.

Construction and demolition waste

Waste from renovation work that you carry out in your own house must be taken to the municipal waste depot. You can hire a special container for this. Call the Netwerk customer service for details. If you carry out renovation work at the home of another person for payment, the resulting waste is considered as business waste. To dispose of this you can buy a bulk waste bag from a home improvement store or hire a skip from a private waste collection company. If you want to remove asbestos, you must always request permission from the municipal authorities. This can be done by calling telephone number 078 - 639 89 89. Asbestos must be brought to the municipal waste depot. This is only allowed if it is packed properly in special plastic. This plastic can be obtained free of charge from the municipal waste depot.

Glass

Empty glass bottles and jars that contained food, drink, cosmetics or medicine must be deposited in the bottle bank. All other glass must be disposed of with the general household waste. Bottle banks can be found at the shopping centres. Large pieces of glass, windows panes and mirrors must be brought to the municipal waste depot.

Electrical equipment

Electrical equipment must be handed in at the store where the replacement appliance is purchased. It can also be brought to the municipal waste depot. Small appliances can be handed over to the de KCA collection van. If you have missed the KCA collection van and are unable to go to the municipal waste depot, you can have the appliances collected from your home. To arrange this you can make an appointment with the Netwerk customer service.

Bulky household waste

Bulky household waste must be brought to the municipal waste depot. If you are unable to do so, you can arrange for this waste to be collected free of charge. You can make an appointment for this via the Internet. The address of the website is www.grofvuil.net. If you do not have an Internet connection, call the Netwerk customer service.



Avoid a fine

You must deposit your refuse in the appropriate containers. Do not put it on the street, otherwise you risk being fined. The fine is at least €60.00 per offence.

The municipal waste depot is free

Bulky household waste and construction and demolition waste can be taken to the municipal waste depot free of charge. The address of the municipal waste depot is Baanhoekweg 8-12. The depot is open from 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Monday through Saturday. It is closed on Sundays and public holidays. Proof of identity is compulsory (driving licence, passport or identity card).
